# **REQUIRED PERMITS – FOOD & LIQUOR**

## ALL FOOD VENDORS

YOU MUST HAVE A SOUTHERN DOWNS REGIONAL COUNCIL PERMIT OR AN APPROVED MOBILE PERMIT FROM YOUR LOCAL COUNCIL TO TRADE AT THIS FESTIVAL

Please ensure you submit your current mobile food licence and PL/COC with your application form

Your application cannot be processed until this is received

No plastic straws or cutlery to be used during festival

Power Cords (if applicable) - please ensure your cords are at least 20metres in length

### **ALL LIQUOR VENDORS**

**Wineries** - FORM 8 Permit from Liquor Licencing is required to attend the festival. Once approved, the permit is to be displayed at your stall site during festival trading times.

RSA is required and is to be enforced at all times at your stall

It is your responsibility to display RSA signage

Craft Brewers – please supply a copy of your permit for the sale of alcohol at the event.
