We also welcome applications from regional small businesses offering unique, creative or experience-driven products—whether that's something fun and different, or garden-inspired offerings such as strawberry plants, pots and related goods that complement the spirit of the festival.

STALLHOLDER APPLICATIONS

Applications for the Stanthorpe Berry Festival will be reviewed from 1 July 2026.

All applicants will be notified via email regarding the outcome of their application. Successful applicants will be issued an invoice to confirm their site allocation.

To secure your position within the festival, payment is required by the specified due date. As sites are limited and in high demand, unpaid allocations may be released to other applicants.

Upon receipt of payment, your site allocation will be confirmed.

Please note that all stallholder fees are non-refundable in the event of cancellation or non-attendance.

Food & Beverage Stallholder Information

To ensure a smooth and high-quality festival experience for both stallholders and patrons, please review the following requirements relevant to your stall type.

Food Vendors & Food Trucks

All food stallholders are required to hold appropriate approval from **Southern Downs Regional Council**, and or a current Mobile Food Licence.

Applications cannot be processed until the relevant approvals or supporting documentation have been received.

Some low-risk food vendors may not require a full food licence; however, written confirmation from Council permitting you to trade must still be provided as part of your application.

To support our sustainability initiatives, the use of single-use plastic straws and cutlery is not permitted at the festival.

Power Access:

Power availability is limited. Stallholders requiring power must supply their own leads (minimum 30 metres) and ensure all equipment is compliant and suitable for event use

Market & Artisan Stalls

All market stallholders are required to hold current Public Liability Insurance and provide a Certificate of Currency (COC) with their application.

Each stallholder is responsible for maintaining their own insurance coverage for the duration of the event.

Liquor Stallholders

Wineries

Wineries must obtain a **Form 8 Permit** through **Queensland Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation** to trade at the festival. Approved permits must be clearly displayed at your stall during trading hours.

Craft Brewers & Other Liquor Vendors

All liquor stallholders are required to provide relevant permits for the sale of alcohol at the event as part of their application.

RSA Requirements

Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) must be implemented at all times. Stallholders are responsible for ensuring all staff are appropriately certified and that RSA signage is clearly displayed at their site.

2026 Site Fees

There are a mixture of sites across the event, including sealed, grassed, dirt and sloping. Therefore chocks, weights and pegs may be required. The final site map & stall allocation information will specify the site allocated to you to approximately 1 week prior to the event date.

ALL STALLHOLDERS are to supply their own marquees and service equipment to trade on the day. The festival supplies the site only. Please note that all stallholder fees are non-refundable in the event of cancellation or non-attendance.
